Privacy Policy

We recognize that our relationships with current and prospective clients are based on integrity and trust. We may disclose some or all of the information we collect to the other medical institutions and government agencies with which we have agreements. Any disclosures will be only to the extent permitted by applicable federal and state law.

Any medical or health information we collect about you will be disclosed to third parties only to administer your policy or claim; as permitted by law, or as authorized by you in writing.

We restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with applicable regulatory standards to guard your nonpublic personal information.
